

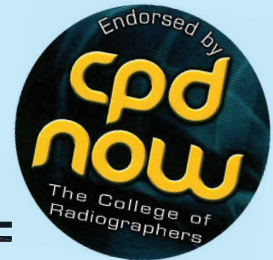


# IMPLEMENTING BEST PRACTICE IN FORENSIC RADIOGRAPHY
