- Only original, unpublished work will be accepted
- Any images used must be fully anonymised and comply fully with copyright and current Data Protection legislation
- Entries to be emailed to secretary@afr.org.uk no later than midnight on Friday 31st July 2009
- Entries will be judged by a panel chosen by the IAFR committee
- Entries should:
 - Demonstrate a critical understanding of best forensic radiography practice with reference to IAFR/SCOR 2008 guidelines
 - Integrate and synthesise relevant sources
 - Demonstrate an ability to present information in a structured and coherent manner
- The decision of the panel will be final
- The prize, of up to £1000, will contribute towards costs incurred in attending the American Academy of Forensic Sciences annual conference in Seattle 2010
- This prize is non transferable and no alternative cash prize will be available
- The winner will be required to produce a report on their attendance at AAFS in conjunction with the IAFR representative.
